#### Activities related to Health and Physical Education

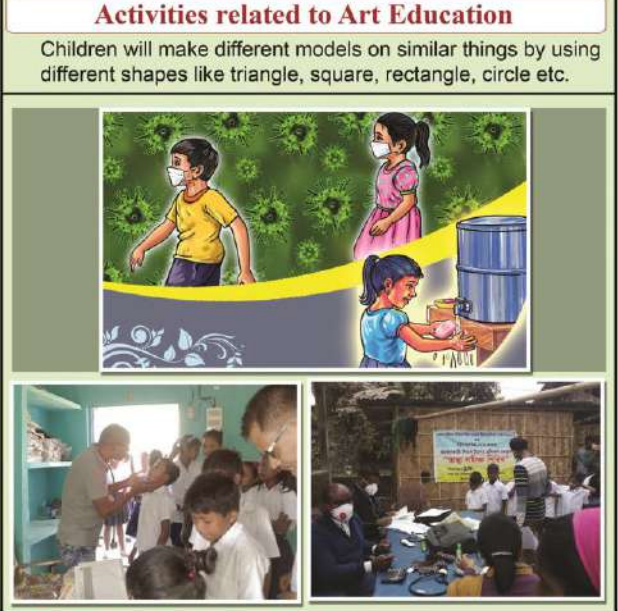
- Children will do exercises for body balancing.

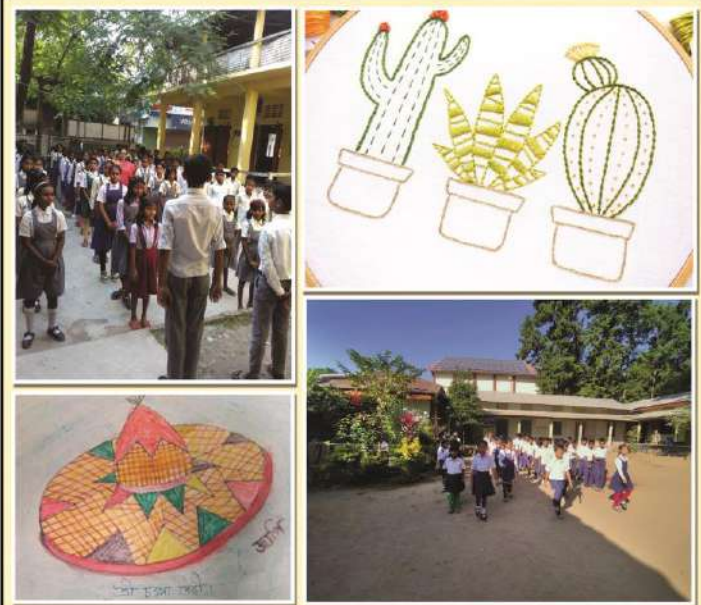
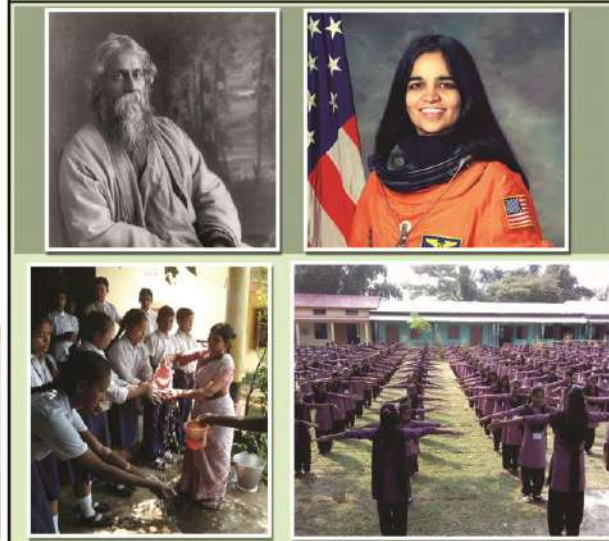
